for Diver

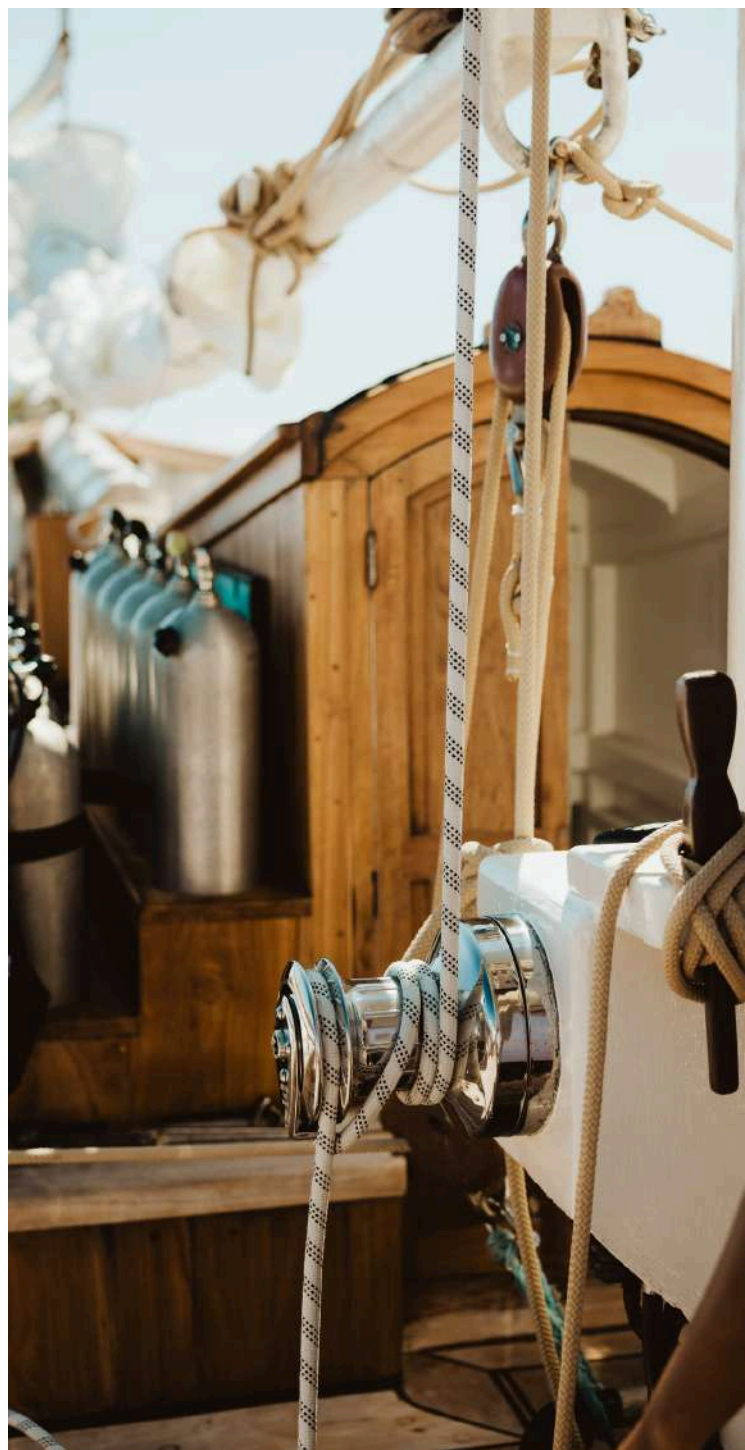
Must Have

- Compulsory diving insurance (such as DAN, DiveAssure or Aquamed or other)
- Health check-up / medical certificate for passengers above 60 years old
(Doctor's note)
- Diving certifications, provided before preferred

Optional

- Diving logbook.
- Your own diving equipment if you wish.

Onboard our tanks are all equipped with International Connecting System (Yoke), hence, please bring your own International-to-DIN adapter if required

Tipping on Board – A Meaningful Gesture

Note: We accept payments in cash (IDR only) and also credit card payments for your convenience

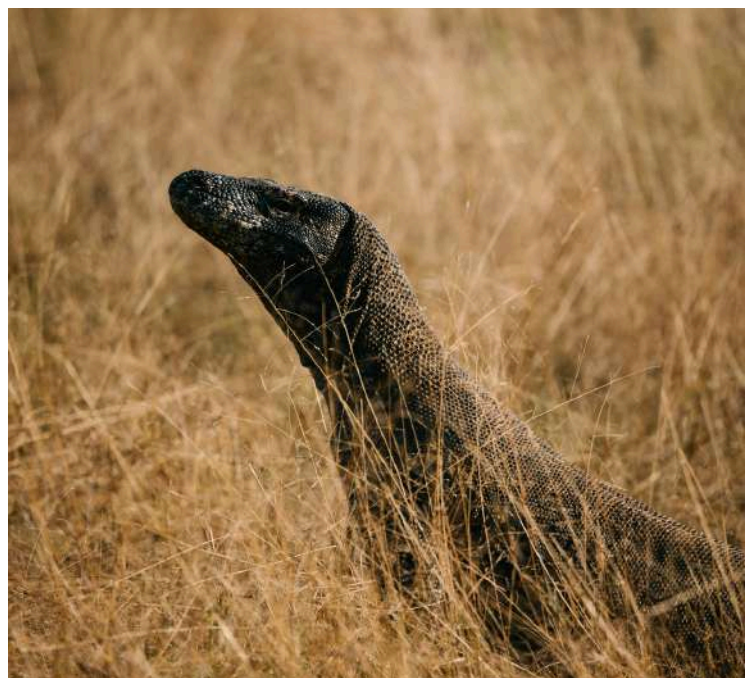
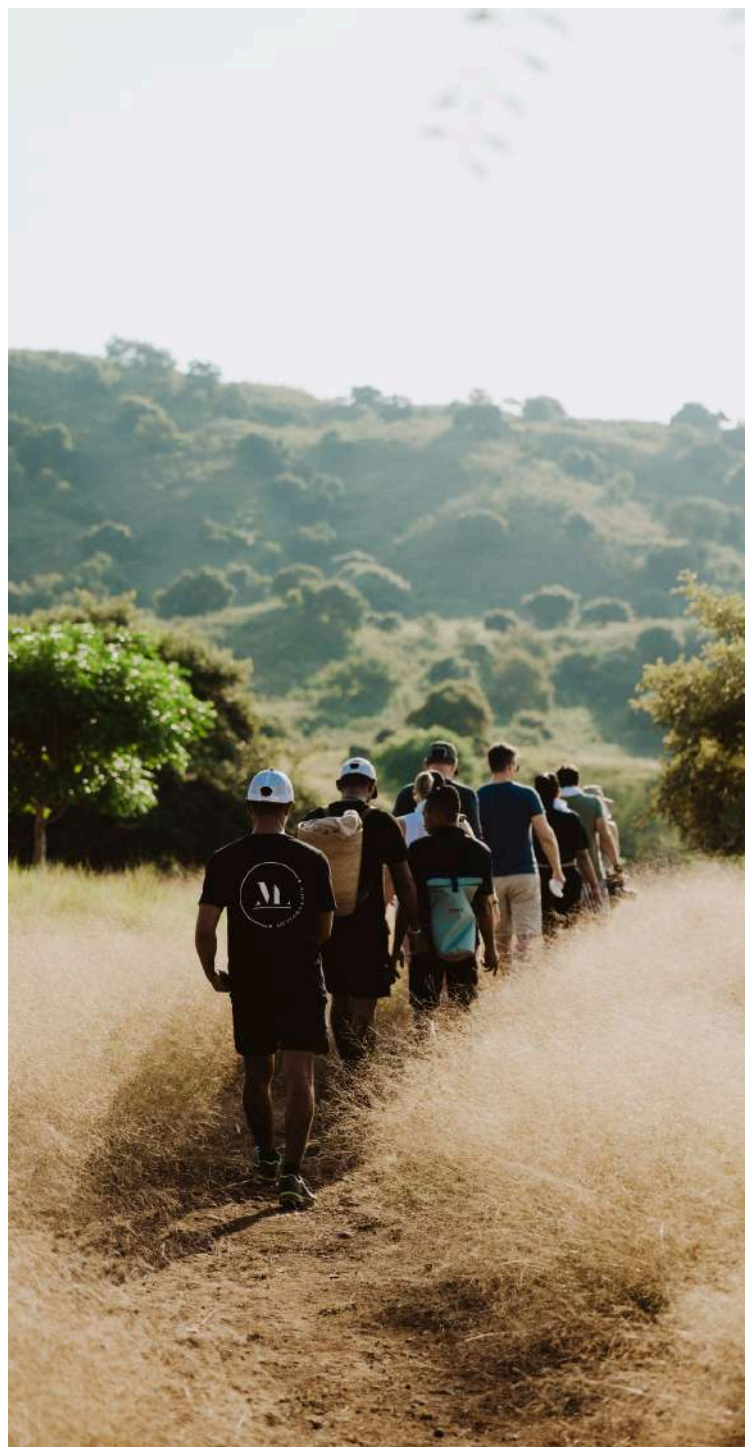


Mosquitoes

There are usually no mosquitoes on the boat because mosquitoes don't like salty waters. We provide mosquitoes spray onboard but you can still bring long light sleeves for the jungle treks.

What *to* Bring

- Personal preference on reef friendly or biodegradable sunscreen
- Swimwear and Rashguard for Snorkelling or Diving to be protected from the sun.
- Cap and sunglasses.
- Close shoes for Trekking
- Personal toiletries
- Universal adaptor, note: we have type C and G sockets onboard
- Camera or Gopro
- Prescribed Medication, note: we cannot purchase prescribed medication on your behalf.
- Local currency for onshore souvenir purchases.

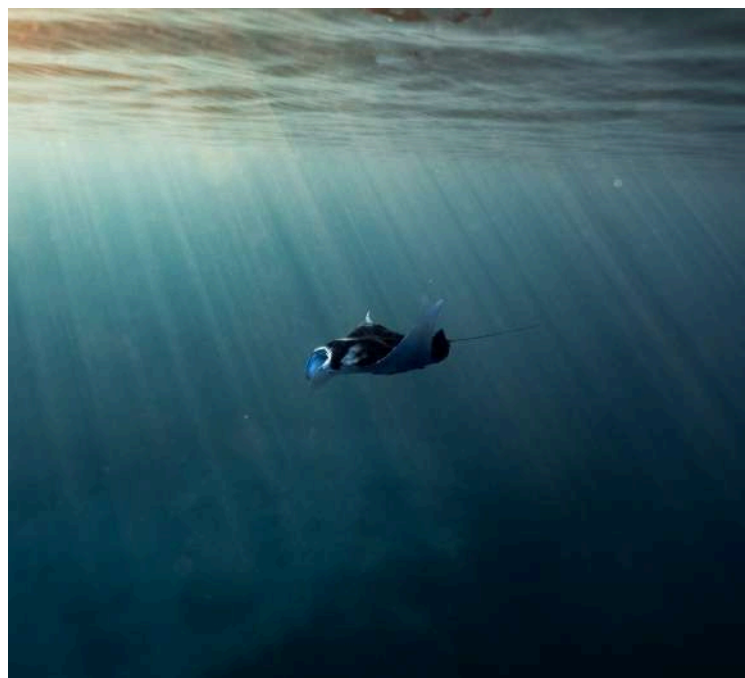
From *the* start, we prioritize environmental preservation through various initiatives

To minimize the use of toilet paper, every bathroom is equipped with showerheads, promoting waste reduction.

Natural Products

Air Conditioning AL
