We're excited to welcome you aboard Kudanil Explorer! To help you prepare, we've outlined a simple guide of what to bring, what's already available onboard, and what's recommended for your comfort throughout the journey.

CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

What to Bring

- ☐ Swimwear (several sets for daily water activities)
- ☐ Rash guard or UV-protective swim shirt
- ☐ Light cover-ups or sarongs
- ☐ Casual daywear in breathable fabrics (cotton, linen)
- ☐ Resort wear for dinners or informal evenings
- ☐ Light sweater or jacket, pashmina or shawl for cooler nights
- ☐ Activewear for hikes and water sports
- ☐ Flip-flops or sandals for transfers, sneakers for island exploration

Please keep in mind that we observe a no-shoes policy onboard

- ☐ Sun hat
- ☐ Polarized sunglasses
- ☐ Optional: formal outfit for special occasions

Available On Board

- ☐ Sarongs
- ☐ Beach Towels

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TOILETRIES AND PERSONAL CARE

What to Bring

- ☐ Moisturizer
- ☐ Lip balm with SPF
- ☐ Facial mist
- ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant
- ☐ Leave-in conditioner and a detangling comb or brush
- ☐ Spa products (face masks, scrubs, essential oils)
- ☐ Personal pillow or blanket if desired
- ☐ Personal medication
- ☐ Sea sickness medication
- ☐ Feminine hygiene products
- ☐ Cigarettes or cigars if desired. We do not sell tobacco onboard, and availability ashore is limited to local brands

Available On Board

- ☐ Bath towels and linens
- ☐ Reef-safe sunscreen (SPF 50+) made from high-quality natural, non-toxic ingredients
- ☐ Natural Aloe Vera after-sun lotion
- ☐ High-quality, natural insect repellent on board
- ☐ A gentle, high-quality, natural body wash, shampoo, and conditioner
- ☐ Hair Dryer
- ☐ First aid kit for basic needs (including seasickness, minor wounds, fever, and common pain relief)

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WATER ACTIVITIES

What to Bring

- ☐ Your own mask and snorkel if preferred
- ☐ Your own fins if preferred

Available On Board

- ☐ Snorkeling gear (mask, snorkel, fins)
- ☐ Scuba gear (wet suits, mask, snorkel, fins, tanks, regulators)
- ☐ Waterproof bags

DOCUMENTS AND ESSENTIALS

- ☐ Passport (valid for at least 6 months)
- ☐ Visa (if applicable)
- ☐ Travel insurance (required for divers)
- ☐ Indonesian Rupiah (IDR) for onshore purchases
- ☐ Credit card (Visa or MasterCard for onboard expenses such as bar and spa)

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TECHNOLOGY AND TOYS

In Indonesia, the plug type is Type C (two round pins – common in Europe)
Type F (also known as Schuko – two round pins with two earth clips on the side)
Voltage: 230 V | Frequency: 50 Hz

This is compatible with most devices from Europe, Australia, and parts of Asia.
If you're coming from North America or Japan, you may need a voltage converter for certain devices (e.g., hair dryers, electric razors), unless they are dual voltage.

- ☐ Camera or GoPro
- ☐ Chargers, power banks, and travel adapters (Type C or F plug)
- ☐ E-reader or paperback
- ☐ Waterproof phone case
- ☐ Dry bag (note: waterproof bags are also available onboard)
- ☐ Drone for aerial photography

You are allowed to bring a drone for recreational or personal use. There is no need to declare it at customs as long as it's not for commercial or professional purposes.

However, if you're bringing professional-grade equipment (especially multiple drones or larger models), you may be questioned and should have documentation ready.

Bring a copy of your drone registration and proof that it's for personal use.

Always ask local guides or the yacht crew if it's okay to fly.
